Named after the World Heritage site in Northern Italy, the Ferrara kitchen range is our most adaptable. This can inspire our clients to choose a design that is either elegant or streamlined in its aesthetic.

The Ferrara's design provides a low-profile framed door that creates a clean, un-cluttered look to the baseline shaker kitchen design.

The Ferrara can be finished with a lacquered hardwood, or a hand brushed painted finish to name but a few, as there are many more options to choose from.

Florence

The Florence design is based on the shaker frame construction, and has the addition of a raised moulding for the door panel.

The moulding around the frame is designed specifically for this range, as it uses a traditional bolection style that varies from a classic shaker design.

All of our ranges are customisable in design with alternative plinth details, paint and material finishes to create an individual look. Due to its classic aesthetic, the Florence range is an excellent choice for period properties.

Turin

The Northern city of Turin, famous for its industry and culture, gave us the inspiration to create a flat surfaced push-to-open design.

The Turin range is available in a variety of paints or solid wood, including oak, ash and walnut. Furthermore, all user-friendly soft closing moving parts come with lifetime warranties.





Tuscany

Ageless in its style, this classic shaker design is one of our most popular ranges.

The striking grain pattern is the trademark of our Tuscany range. Every door and framework is crafted from solid oak or ash, so regardless of the chosen finish, the tactile grain gives the Tuscany its distinctive look and character.

Our Process

Here at Minerva, we wish to maintain a friendly yet professional relationship with our clientele. This gives us the opportunity to work side-by-side with them throughout the journey to create their bespoke kitchen.

There are five simple steps in our process:

1 First Meeting & Estimation

After the initial meeting, we can provide you with a provisional estimate, together with a simple CAD plan. Once you are happy with the initial design and costings, we will then move onto the detail design stage.


2 Design

From the start, we will help you choose a style from one of our ranges, and select the overall colour scheme. Samples will be viewed to demonstrate the colours, various finishes and materials that will be used to create your new worktops and units.

The ergonomics of the overall layout will be taken into consideration, which ensures that everything is easy to use and in reach.

We will give advice on the features of the new kitchen, such as its storage requirements, the appliances, feature lighting, ironmongery and the shelving.

In addition, our Lead Designer will create on the computer a 3D render of your new kitchen design. This is to give you an indication of how the colours and materials will look alongside the units within your kitchen space.



3 Client Confirmation & Manufacturing

A provisional date for manufacturing will be made on confirmation from the client and work will be scheduled, materials bought and trades booked. At this stage, we will ask for a minimum deposit of 10%.

We must preface that the process of creating a handmade kitchen requires time and attention to detail. We want to make the best kitchen for you.

Closer to the manufacturing date, we will be able to provide accurate dates that are suitable for fitting, and final preparations can be made.

4 Fitting the Kitchen

During the process of fitting your new kitchen, we will use our own specialised fitters, so no subcontractors will be used. In addition to this, during your visits to our showroom, you will be able to meet our craftsmen in the workshop.

For worktop materials such as marble, granite and quartz, they will be installed approximately 7 days after the kitchen units have been installed. This is to allow for the time for specialists to template and cut your worktop to fit your kitchen to perfection.

5 Project Completion *& Warranty*

After all the work has been completed, the project will be signed off by the client. Soon after, we will provide you with an information pack for your new kitchen. This will provide you with details on our 15 year warranty, which covers the cabinetry and joinery.

Throughout this process, we will build a working relationship that we aim to continue into the future.
